


# WELCOME TO LEEDS BEST OF BRASS 2025/26!

# **FODEN'S BAND**

Formed in 1902, Foden's Band has maintained its position as one of the world's leading bands on and off the contest stage, and currently holds the record for the highest number of Area Contest wins with an unprecedented 27 North West Area titles. In 2023, the band became British Open Champion at Birmingham's Symphony Hall and was crowned Brass in Concert Champion. In 2024, Foden's Band completed a seven day tour of South Korea where its opening concert was broadcast on national TV.

# **KNDS FAIREY BAND**

The KNDS Fairey Band is one of the most successful contesting brass bands in the world. Founded in 1937 by a group of employees at the Fairey Aviation Works in Stockport, the band achieved many musical successes under the brilliant direction of Harry Mortimer, its Musical Director for over thirty years. Since those early days, the band has won every elite band event on the contest calendar, including the National Championships of Great Britain on nine occasions and the British Open an incredible sixteen times.

## **GUS BAND**

Originally known as the Munn and Felton Works Band, GUS Band has established itself as one of the leading brass bands, with a string of titles to its name and regular appearances at the National Brass Band Championships at the Royal Albert Hall. Despite the changes in the band's history over time, one thing that remains the same is the standards and ideals started by Fred Felton and his brother in 1933 when they formed the band and proclaimed: 'We are a oing to aim high.'

# **GRIMETHORPE COLLIERY BAND**

Formed in 1917 in South Yorkshire, Grimethorpe Colliery Band is a British institution. National and British Open Champion on numerous occasions, the band received two gold discs and a BAFTA nomination for its contributions to the global hit movie *Brassed Off.* The band has long championed new music for brass and is noted for its diverse concert performances, including the FIFA World Cup, BAFTA Awards, BBC Proms, Eurovision, and London 2012 Olympic Games Opening Ceremony.

## **BLACK DYKE BAND**

With a heritage stretching back to 1855, Black Dyke Band's pedigree is unrivalled. Over 350 recordings and numerous national and European competition titles have made the name Black Dyke synonymous with musical excellence. With renowned Musical Director Nicholas Childs at the helm, the band champions new music for brass, often performing music by living composers. A popular highlight of the band's concerts is *Black Dyke at the Movies*, a cinematic celebration of iconic film scores. Most recently Black Dyke Band featured in BBC's *Radio 2 Loves Brass* concert as part of Bradford 2025 City of Culture, performing with The Punjabi Roots Drummers and Marti Pellow.

# **HAMMONDS BAND**

Founded in 1855 as the Saltaire Band by Sir Titus Salt, the band had a long association with Hammonds Sauce Works. Now, with Morgan Griffiths as Musical Director, the band performs as Hammonds Band. Alongside contesting and performing throughout Europe, the band has also enjoyed working with multi-instrumentalist Shri Sriram to fuse brass band and traditional Indian music together. In 2024 the band welcomed former winner of the prestigious Craxton Memorial Trust Award, Anabel Voigt on solo horn.

# **ROTHWELL TEMPERANCE BAND**

Rothwell Temperance Band is the highest ranked brass band from Leeds. With no benefactors or major sponsors, the band's success in recent times is down to the dedication and passion of its Musical Director, David Roberts, and the band's loyal players. Rothwell has remained a championship section band for over 25 years and has had a consistent presence among the top 20 brass bands in the world. The band has many talented musicians in its ranks including its latest signing Maria Beezer on Principal Cornet.

# **BRIGHOUSE & RASTRICK BAND**

Brighouse & Rastrick Band is regarded by many as the best and most consistent 'public subscription band' in the world. The band is most known for its 1977 hit parade success *The Floral Dance* which reached No 2 in the UK charts. High profile appearances on live-television at the BBC Folk Music Awards with The Unthanks, and at the very popular CarFest, are just some of the ways that the band has expanded its popularity. With 140 years of proud history, the band is still fiercely financially independent and continues to maintain great traditions on its continued quest for musical excellence.

Pudsey Civic Hall is a popular events venue located in west Leeds.



There are excellent public transport links to Pudsey Civic Hall. The 72 bus runs every 15-20 minutes between Leeds Bus Station and Bradford Bridge Street. There are regular trains from Leeds, Bradford and beyond to New Pudsey rail station, which is a five-minute walk from Pudsey Civic Hall.
